#### CYCLING CONNECTS - CONFERENCE 2014

#### **GDANSK: 1ST CYCLING MONITOR INAUGURATED**

The installation of the cycling monitor is accompanied by a promotional campaign that is carried out in extensive

## STUDY TRIP: CYCLING AND SUSTAINABLE URBAN DEVELOPMENT IN FREIBURG AND BASEL



In September 2013 a group of 22 experts from Rostock, Gdansk, Kalmar and Karlskrona took part in a two day study trip to Freiburg (Germany) and Basel (Switzerland). Both cities are very ambitious to promote cycling as a part of their multimodal transport system. The participants could experience the spirit of sustainable urban development during their walk and guided cycling tour in Freiburg. #### **SOUTH BALTIC EDUTAINMENT DAY 2013**



Over 400 school students from Denmark, Lithuania and Poland got inspired during the South Baltic Edutainment Day 2013 on 18th September 2013 in Gdansk. Several South Baltic projects came up with innovative ideas following the main theme of the maritime cross-border co-operation in keeping with the tagline "Catch the South Baltic winds in your

sails, explore, discover, get inspired!". The abc.multimodal team presented folded bicycles, used on daily basis by the City of Gdansk officials, as an example how to integrate bikes into the multimodal transport system.







### GOOD PRACTICE: 10 CAMPAIGNS, 5 EVALUATIONS
